2. Public Forum – The Clerk advised that Mr Fenner, who was due to speak, was unable to attend due to family member illness, and had asked the clerk to speak on his behalf. Mr Fenner and the village Hall Committee request permission to hold a village celebration of the Queen's birthday on Saturday June 11th from approx 4pm to 9pm which will include music, games and BBQ.
