Public highlighted to council concerns re the Governments 'Heating and Building Strategy case ref PA15843) and a Consultation Oct 2021 – Jan 2022' to introduce targeted regulations that will drive decarbonisation of heat specifically in off gas grid homes. Council was presented with a briefing paper. Council agreed to circulate this and raise concerns with Peter Aldous MP.
